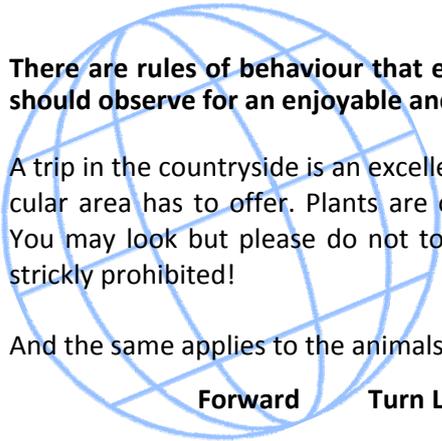


Signage chart

• **Little Hikes PR** : there is 3 types:

- PR 1 - loop of 4 to 10 km,
- PR 2 - loop of 11 to 17 km,
- PR 3 - loop of de 18 km and more .

Some advices :

Before the Hike :

- Do not take a hard path if you are not well prepared
- Prepare your itineray !
- Take a compass and a map.
- Wear a good pair of walking boots
- Keep an eye on the weather forecast before you leave.
- Make sure you have sufficient water ; water is the best remedy if you start feel tired.

In the hunting season (autumn - winter), there are signs that tell you where there is hunting. You are then prohibited from walking, cycling or riding a horse in these areas.

If lumberjacks are at work in the woods where you are, then make sure they know you are there.

The traffic regulations : mountain bikers should give priority to horses, who themselves shoul give priority to people on foot.

During the Hike

- Stay on the marked paths
- Respect all private properties
- Take your rubbish with you and don't start a Fire
- Make sure that your car is parked so that it is not in anybody's way, for example near the entrance to a road or a farm.
